WORKSHOPS

A. Traumatiserade barn

B. Parent collaboration based on MindSpring

In this workshop we present the concept of MindSpring as well as look at the need for, and the possibilities to, implement the program in Finland.

The purpose of MindSpring for parents is to empower and support their parenting skills as well as prevent or counter family related and psychosocial problems and failure to thrive amongst their children. In MindSpring groups for parents, the focus is on parenting and child education, norms and values, the rights of children as well as identity, stress, and trauma. Thus, the main theme is exile-related issues stemming from educating children in a new cultural setting while being affected by a past of war and flight.

C. Systemic injustices

In this workshop, participants will identify structural injustices and challenges to equity/opportunity of newly-arrived immigrant children and youth in school, daycare and leisure activities. Participants will then outline potential solutions to these challenges and identify areas (who, when, what and how) for additional support and training needed to bridge the gap between where we are now and where we would like to be as a democratic society. This workshop is for anyone working for the interest of children and youth, who wants to strengthen and grow a more flexible and cross-sectoral toolkit.
